

MINIMUM REQUIRED CLOTHING AND PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION EMPLOYEES COVERED BY COMPTRUSTAGC

- **SHIRTS WITH AT LEAST A FOUR INCH SLEEVE**
Tank tops, sleeveless shirts or unbuttoned shirts are not permitted.
- **LONG PANTS**
Shorts or loose-type pants are not permitted.
- **LEATHER WORK BOOTS WITH A HARD SOLE**
Canvas-type shoes or shoes with a soft sole are not permitted.
- **HARD HATS**
Hard hats must be worn anytime falling, projectile or strike-against hazards are present.
- **EYE PROTECTION**
Eye protection must be worn while operating (or nearby) any power tool, striking metal against metal, using chemicals, burning or welding, chipping or when flying particles are present in the air.
- **HEARING PROTECTION**
Hearing protection must be worn anytime there is a noise exposure of 85 decibels or greater for an 8 hour TWA, or when there is a noise exposure of 115 decibels.
- **RESPIRATORY PROTECTION**
Respiratory protection must be worn where there is a breathing hazard. Protection must be designed to protect against a particular hazard or oxygen deficiency. A written company program, medical evaluation and fit testing records are required when employees wear respirators.
- **GENERAL**
Clothing and employee-supplied personal protective equipment shall be in good condition. Synthetic clothing that may catch fire, melt or otherwise compound a burn type injury will not be worn around hot work such as welding, brazing, burning, etc.
